1. Room Booking Rules and Regulations

1.1 General Rules

- Each student can book a room up to 7 days in advance
- Each student is given a rolling advance booking quota (after each hour is used, it is reimbursed):
 - Instrumental and Voice majors = 15 hours
 - o Composition, AAS, MS/MCP (3rd & 4th year) and Conducting = 6 hours
- Total hour of bookings is capped at 3 hours during peak period (11am to 10pm daily). There is no cap on bookings made during non-peak period.
- The minimum booking length is 1 hour
- The maximum booking length is 2 hours
- There must be a minimum of 1-hour gap between 2 bookings
- The booking time will be rounded off to the nearest half-hour
 - Example 1: Rounding-up (hh:15 hh:29 / hh:45 hh:59)

A booking starting at 11:15am to 12:15pm will be

rounded up to 11:30am to 12:30pm

Example 2: Rounding-down (hh:01 – hh:14 / hh:31 – hh:44)

A booking starting at 11:37am to 1:37pm will be rounded

down to 11:30am to 1.30pm

 Students are not allowed to make a booking on current time or for a time that has passed


Example: If the time now is 2pm, you will not be able to make a

booking starting at 2pm. The nearest possible booking

starting time will be 2.30pm due to rounding off.

1.2 Free Booking Horizon

Students are given a Free Booking Horizon of 75 minutes. Any booking made within this Free Booking Horizon will not count into the quota. In addition, if the quotas have been reached, students may still book a room using the Free Booking Horizon.



Example: If a room is available from 3pm to 4pm, and you wish to book using the Free Booking Horizon, you can only do so from 2.45pm to 2.59pm.

1.3 Restrictions

- Performance venues (Concert Hall, Orchestra Hall and Steven Baxter Recital Studio) are not available for booking via ASIMUT. To use these facilities, please write to Programming & Productions (Ms Poo Lai Fong) at laifong@nus.edu.sg.
 Requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis and subject to availability.
- Some practice rooms can be booked by specific students depending on their major study:

- Only Ensemble Rooms 3 to 8 are open for bookings by students.
- Students may book any of the Seminar Rooms but only within the Free Booking allowance ie no advance booking. This booking will not be counted into the quota.
- The first available booking time slot is 8am and the last is from 10.30pm to 11.30pm
- Students away on Exchange, Leave of Absence, and etc are not granted access to book any rooms


1.4 Cancellation






2.2 Checking Schedule


Your schedule of activities for the current week is displayed here 7 days at a time. To check another week or day schedule, select the date in the calendar.








Display of your available booking quota






2.5 Examples of Booking Errors


No Unused Booking Quota




Booking Hours Exceed Peak Hour Cap

No Permission to Book the Room




Only Allowed to Book within the 'Free Booking Horizon'
